Trip Details...

Sunday, March 26, 2023: Fly from to Honduras (San Pedro Sula or Comayagua Honduras)

Monday-Thursday: Work on building the new school (building playgrounds, painting buildings, landscaping, playing with children, etc.

Saturday, April 1, 2023: Fly from Honduras back to the USA.

A Day in Honduras...

Participate in a project to help a local community in the rural mountains to build a new school for their children! Here is the schedule for a typical day on the trip:

7:00 am - Breakfast as a team

8:00 am - Travel to the local community

9:00 am – Paint, build a playground, plant trees, pour concrete sidewalks, stucco, and more!

12:00 pm - Lunch on the work site

1:00 pm – Work & Play! Make time for a soccer game or jump rope with the kids.

3:00 pm – Stop by a local tourist attraction such as the Pulhapanzak Waterfall.

5:00 pm - Back to the lodge or hotel

6:00 pm – Dinner as a team and team meeting to prepare for the next day.

7:00 pm - Rest and relaxation



Lodging & Transportation

Team members will fly together from Houston into San Pedro Sula, Honduras. After arriving in Honduras, the team will travel by private vehicle to our lodging accommodations.

Team members will sleep in 1 to 3 person cabins with twin beds. Each day, the team will eat breakfast and dinner in the hotel dining room. We will pack lunches to bring to the work sites.

During the day, the team will travel to and from the work site in vehicles driven by local drivers with extensive knowledge of the area. We'll enjoy some breath-taking views of the mountains along the way!

On the last night of the trip, the team will stay at a hotel in San Pedro Sula and celebrate their accomplishments.

Safety & Security

The team will be led by our experienced Honduran staff and accompanied by a SCW:USA founder and staff member, veteran trip members, and private security as needed. Team members will travel and work in groups at all times.

During the days, the team will be working in rural villages, 2-3 hours from the nearest city of San Pedro Sula. While on site, SCW takes all necessary precautions to ensure that team members are safe and comfortable. The team will have plenty of water and a first aid kit at all times. In case of injury, there is a medical clinic in the nearby town of Santa Cruz de Yojoa and full, modern hospitals in San Pedro Sula.

Trip Costs

Trip costs are \$2,300 per person. This includes airfare, lodging, meals, and local transportation.
